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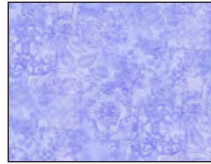

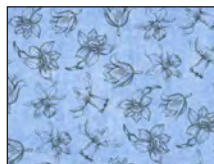

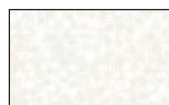

# Belvedere Wall Hanging

## Materials

*Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.*

One 3819P-56 Hyacinth 24" Panel  
 ¼ yard 3812-51 Damask - Peri  
 ⅜ yard 3817-22 Peonies - Pink  
 ⅜ yard 9570-09 Jot Dot - Marshmallow  
 ½ yard 9570-55 Jot Dot - Purple  
 ¾ yard 3818-56 Large Floral - Hyacinth  
 2¾ yards 3814-11 Sketched Blooms - Blue  
 for backing  
 48" x 68" piece of Air Lite® Colour Me 100%  
 Cotton batting

## Cut Fabrics

*Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise indicated.*

### From 3819P-56 Hyacinth 24" Panel:

\*Trim panel to 22" x 42".

### From 3812-51 Damask – Peri, cut:

\*(5) 1¼" x WOF strips for border 5.

### From 3817-22 Peonies – Pink, cut:

\*(4) 2½" x WOF strips for border 2.

### From 9570-09 Jot Dot – Marshmallow, cut:

\*(8) 1½" x WOF strips for borders 1 and 3.

### From 9570-55 Jot Dot – Purple, cut:

\*(6) 2½" x WOF strips for binding.

### From 3818-56 Large Floral – Hyacinth, cut:

\*(5) 4½" x WOF strips for border 4.

### From 3814-11 Sketched Blooms – Blue, cut:

\*(2) 48" x WOF panels, pieced horizontally.

## Assemble Quilt Top

1. For border 1, join all the 1½" 9570-09 Jot Dot – Marshmallow strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length

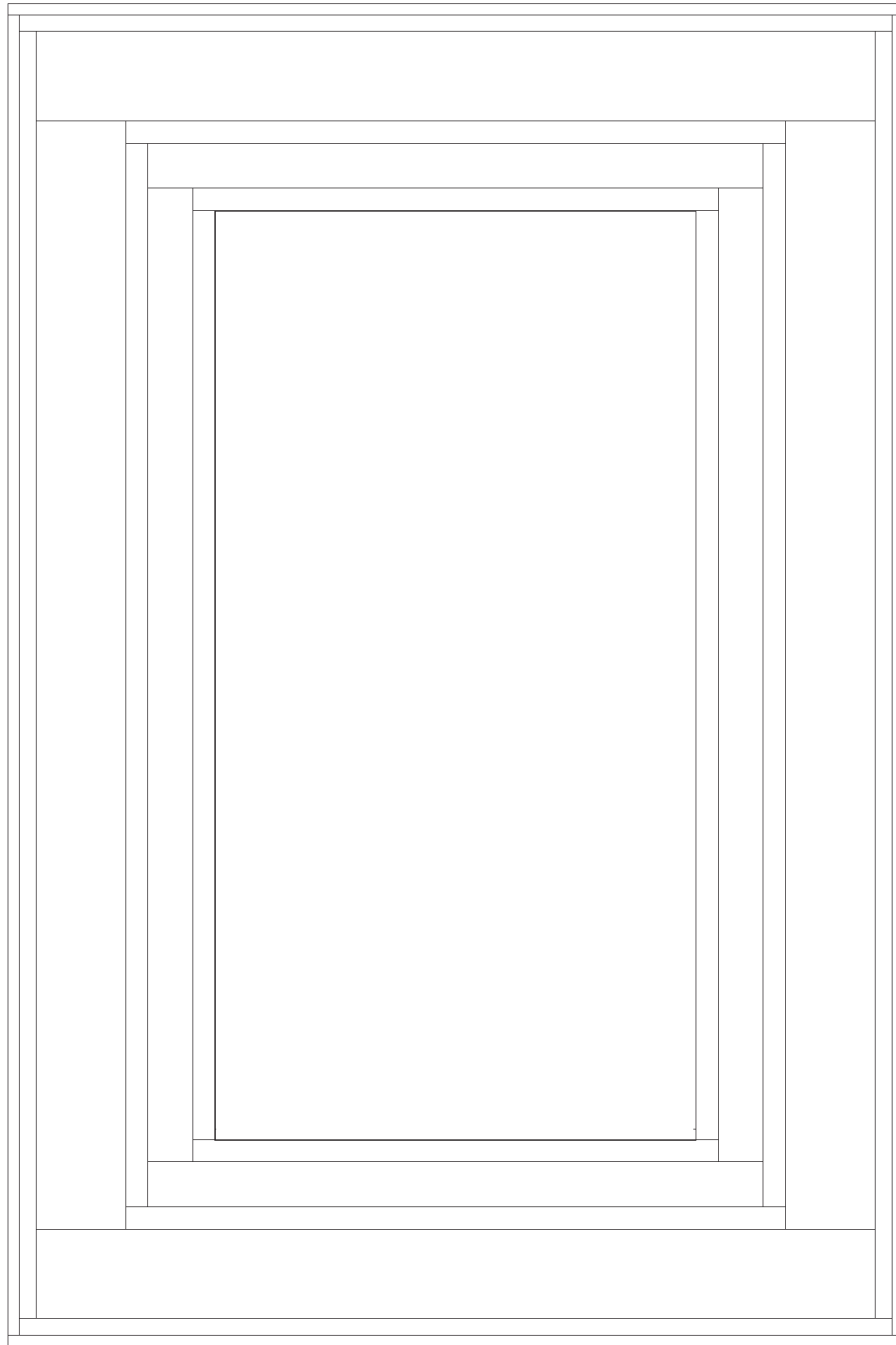
of the quilt top through the center and cut two border strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams toward the border strips. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders. Save the remainder of the long strip for border 3.

2. Repeat Step 1 with the (4) 2½" 3817-22 Peonies - Pink strips to make and add border 2.
3. Repeat Step 1, using the remaining 1½" Marshmallow long strip to make and add border 3.
4. Repeat Step 1 with the (5) 4½" 3818-56 Large Floral - Hyacinth strips to make and add border 4.
5. Repeat Step 1 with the (5) 1¼" 3812-51 Damask - Peri strips to make and add border 5.

## Finishing

6. Create a sandwich with the batting between the quilt top and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark the quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove the pins or basting, and trim the batting and backing even with the raw edges of the quilt top.
7. Join the (6) 2½" 9570-55 Jot Dot - Purple binding strips together end to end using a diagonal seam to make one long strip. With wrong sides facing, fold in half lengthwise and press. Sew the binding to the edges of the quilt, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold the binding to the back of the quilt and stitch it in place by hand to finish.
