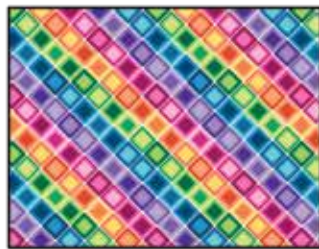

¾ yard	Mini Sunburst – White (B)	2416-01
¾ yard	Starlet – Lilac (C)	6383-Lilac
2 ⅓ yards	Starlet – White (D)	6383-White
⅓ yard	Mini Squares – Purple (E)	2417-55
½ yard	Butterflies – Purple (F)	2409-55
¼ yard	Starlet – Pink (G)	6383-Pink
½ yard	Daisies – Aqua (H)	2411-76
¼ yard	Starlet – Yellow (I)	6383-Yellow
½ yard	Scrolls – Blue (J)	2414-77
¼ yard	Starlet – Petal (K)	6383-Petal
⅜ yard	Funky Bangles – Fuchsia (L)	2412-22
¼ yard	Starlet – Kelly (M)	6383-Kelly
⅔ yard	Stripe – White (N)	2413-01*
4 ¼ yards	Large Sunburst – White (Backing)	2415-01

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.*

#### From the Large Sunburst - White (A), cut:

- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 74 ½" strips.

#### From the Mini Sunburst - White (B), cut:

- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 74 ½" strips.

#### From the Starlet - Lilac (C), cut:

- (11) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (6) 2" x 74 ½" strips.

#### From the Starlet - White (D), cut:

- (6) 13 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (3) 13 ½" x 74 ½" strips.

#### From the Mini Squares - Purple (E), cut:

- See instructions to cut (18) Circles.

#### From the Butterflies - Purple (F), cut:

- See instructions to cut (4) Circles.
- See instructions to cut (32) Large Blades.

#### From the Starlet - Pink (G), cut:

- See instructions to cut (32) Small Blades.

#### From the Daisies - Aqua (H), cut:

- See instructions to cut (4) Circles.
- See instructions to cut (32) Large Blades.

#### From the Starlet - Yellow (I), cut:

- See instructions to cut (32) Small Blades.

#### From the Scrolls - Blue (J), cut:

- See instructions to cut (4) Circles.
- See instructions to cut (32) Large Blades.

#### From the Starlet - Petal (K), cut:

- See instructions to cut (32) Small Blades.

#### From the Funky Bangles - Fuchsia (L), cut:

- See instructions to cut (3) Circles.
- See instructions to cut (24) Large Blades.

#### From the Starlet - Kelly (M), cut:

- See instructions to cut (24) Small Blades.

#### From the Stripe - White (N), cut:

- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

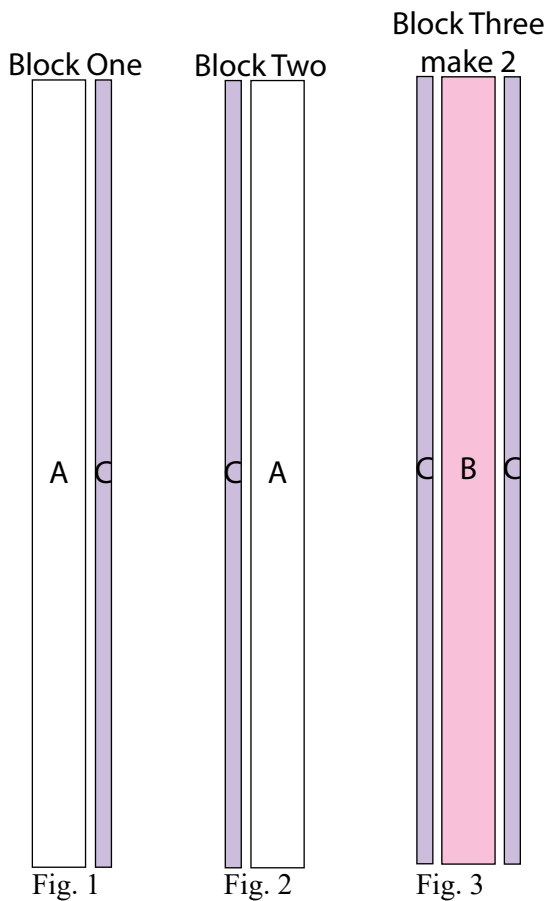
#### From the Large Sunburst - White (Backing), cut:

- (2) 76" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 76" x 82" back.

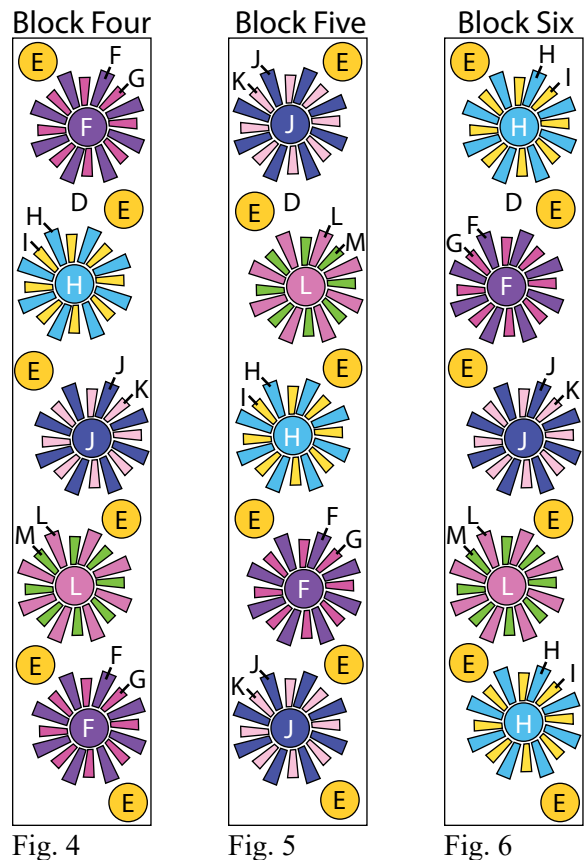
### Block Assembly

Use a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1)  $2'' \times 74 \frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric C strip to the right side of (1)  $5 \frac{1}{2}'' \times 74 \frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric A strip lengthwise to make (1) Block One column (Fig. 1).
2. Sew (1)  $2'' \times 74 \frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric C strip to the left side of (1)  $5 \frac{1}{2}'' \times 74 \frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric A strip lengthwise to make (1) Block Two column (Fig. 2).
3. Sew (1)  $2'' \times 74 \frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric C strip to the each side of (1)  $5 \frac{1}{2}'' \times 74 \frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric B strip lengthwise to make (1) Block Three column (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Block Three column.



4. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about  $\frac{1}{8}''$  outside the drawn lines.
5. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
6. Refer to the Figure 4 to arrange and press the small blades for (5) flowers, the large blades for (5) flowers and (11) circles onto (1)  $13 \frac{1}{2}'' \times 74 \frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric D strip.
7. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Block Four column.
8. Repeat Steps 6-7 and refer to Figures 5-6 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (1) Block Five column and (1) Block Six column.

## Quilt Top Assembly

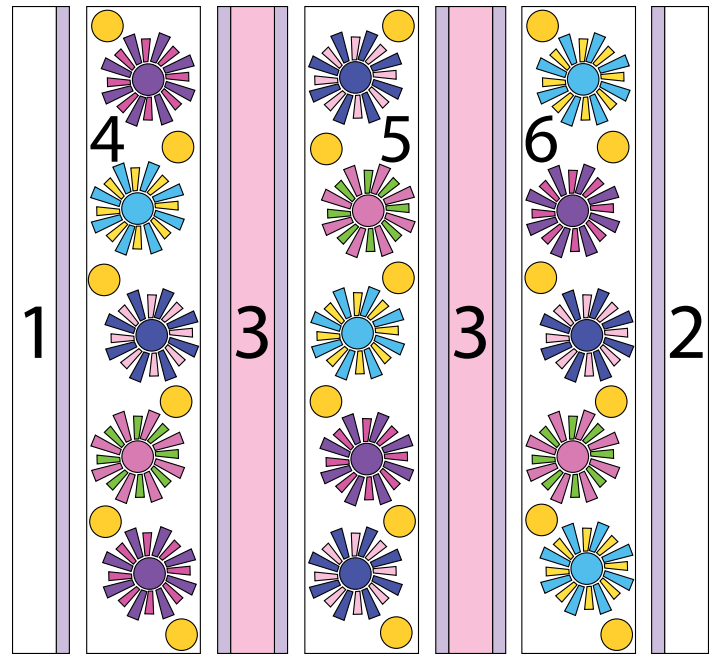
(Follow the *Quilt Layout* while assembling the quilt top.)

9. Sew together the Block One column, the Block Four column, (1) Block Three column, the Block Five column, (1) Block Three column, the Block Six column and the Block Two column, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make the quilt top.

10. Layer and quilt as desired.

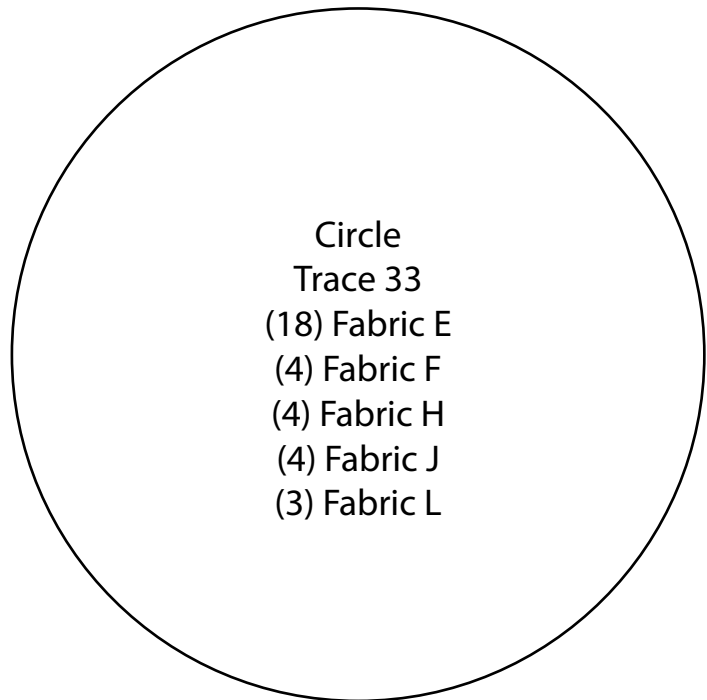
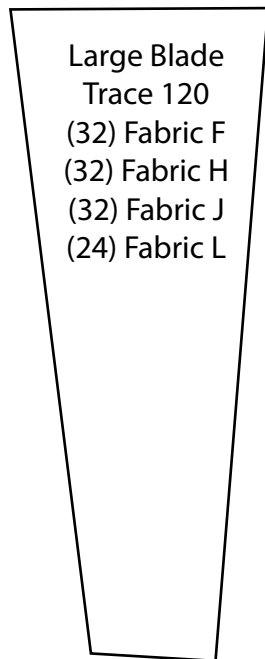
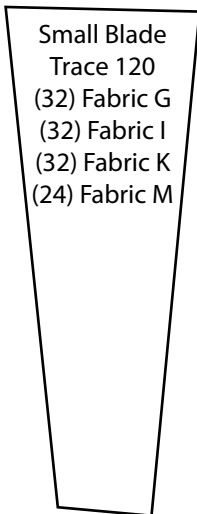
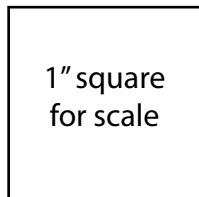
11. Sew the (8) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric N strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

12. Bind as desired.
