
Batting: Matilda's Own 99M400, 100% cotton, 94" (240 cm) wide 55" (140 cm)

In addition: Matching sewing and quilting thread. Inch ruler.

CUTTING **C**: 1/4" seam allowance is included.

SEWING OF QUILT TOP: Seam allowance is 1/4".

This quilt is made with 4 identical blocks, see sketch.

The finished size of the block is 20" x 20".

Each block is made from 9 smaller blocks.


The center is one big square.

The four corner blocks and the smaller between blocks are made with squares, quick corner triangles and half square triangles.

See the next page for how to make these blocks.



For making the quick corner triangles, take the rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " in fabric D-K and some of the squares $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " in fabric A & B.

Draw a diagonal line on the back side of the light squares. Place a square at one end of a rectangle, see sketch. Sew on the drawn line, cut beside line so seam allowance will be 1/4". Turn triangle and press towards dark side and a triangle come forward.

Place a matching or a different square at the other end, having same direction of the diagonal line. Sew on drawn line and cut beside seam. Turn and press.

Be aware that the triangles are placed differently, see block sketch on previous page and above sketches.



Make below combinations:

Rectangle F+A (= A at both ends, diagonal /), I+A, J+A, K+A: each 4 pieces.


Rectangle D+A (= A at both ends, diagonal \setminus), E+A, G+A, H+A: each 4 pieces.

Rectangle F+A+B (= A at one end, B at the other end, diagonal \checkmark), K+A+B: each 8 pieces.

Rectangle D+A+B (= A at one end, B at the other end, diagonal \checkmark), I+A+B: each 8 pieces.

For the half square triangles take the squares $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " in fabric A & B and fabric D-K.

Draw a diagonal line on the light squares. Place one light square and one red or green square right sides together. Sew on both sides of the drawn line. Cut at drawn line and two squares come forward. Recut to size $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make below combinations:

Fabric D+B (one of each = 2 squares), E+B, F+B, G+B, H+B, I+B, J+B, K+B: each 4 pieces.

Place above pieces according to block sketch on page 2.

With right sides together join each corner and each between block.

Now place corners and between blocks and center square in fabric B so you'll get a nine patch, having different sizes of each part.

Join the rows and afterwards join the rows. A block is created.

Make 4 blocks.

Join the blocks and the center piece is created.

Now take the strips in fabric A.

Join a strip at both the left and right sides (A1). The lenght must be around $40\frac{1}{2}$ ". Trim ends. And join a square at the short end of two strips and measure so a square can be join matching the seam at the other end. Join this square and join the strips to the top and the bottom sides (A2).

Next take the strips in fabric M and join them two by two and at the short end. Find center of left side of the center piece and place seam here. Join the strip (L1). The lenght of the strip at the left and right sides must be around $44\frac{1}{2}$ ". Trim ends. At last join the strips at the top and at the bottom (L2). The lenght here must be around $50\frac{1}{2}$ ". Trim ends.

The quilt top is created.

QUILTING AND BINDING:

Layer top, batting and backing fabric and baste the pieces.

Quilt as you prefer by hand or by machine \bigcirc .

Sew hanging sleeve in backing fabric and place under top binding in fabric M **O**.
