Fabrics from series "Star-Glitter" and "Melange", both 44" (112 cm) wide.

OTHER SUPPLIES:

Batting: Matilda's Own 99M400, 100% cotton, 94" (240 cm) wide 22" (55 cm)

In addition: Matching sewing and quilting thread.

Inch ruler.

1/4" seam allowance is included.


Fabric A:	1 Rectangle	14½″ X 16½″
Fabric D [.]	8 Squares	21/2" x 21/2" (ce

Fabric D:8 Squares $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (center)Fabric L & M:each 4 Squares $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (center)Fabric B, E, G, I:each 2 Strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " (center)Fabric C, F, H, J:each 2 Strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " (center)

Fabric K: 1 Rectangle 10½" x 16½"

Fabric L & M: 1 Strip 23/4 x 44" Binding +

1 Strip 2³/₄ x 24" Binding



SEWING OF TABLE RUNNER TOP: Seam allowance is 1/4".

This table runner is made with quick corner triangles, placed towards the center of the runner. See text and sketch below for how to make such quick corner triangles.

Start making the quick corner triangles at one end of the red and green strips in fabric B-C and E-J.


Take the squares in fabric D, L and M. Draw a diagonal line on the back side of the squares. Place a square at one end of a strip, see layout page 3 for colour combinations. Sew on the drawn line, cut beside seam so seam allowance will be 1/4". Turn triangle and press towards strip side and a triangle come forward.

IMPORTANT:

There is two ways to place the diagonal line, see sketch.

Therefore be very aware of the correct placement before sewing so the triangle will look as layout page 3.

Make 2 times 4 red strips and make 2 times 4 green strips.



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Next join the strips according to below layout, having the quick corner triangles towards the center. And join the rectangles in fabric A and K at the ends.


QUILTING AND BINDING:


Layer top, batting and backing fabric and baste the pieces.

Quilt as you prefer by hand or by machine **3**.

Sew top binding in fabric L and M \bigcirc . One end and one side are red and the other end and the other side are green.
