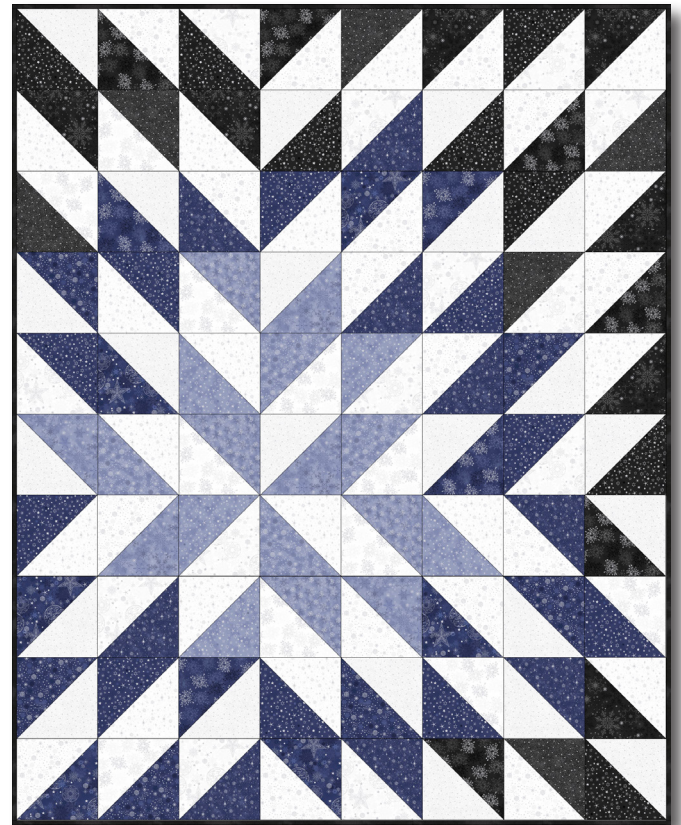

In addition: Matching sewing and quilting thread.

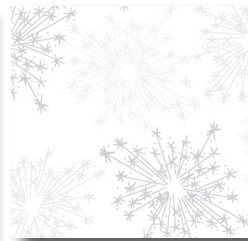

Fabric C:	9 Squares	8 ¹ / ₈ " x 8 ¹ / ₈ " (20,5 x 20,5 cm)
Fabric A:	7 Squares	8 ¹ / ₈ " x 8 ¹ / ₈ " (20,5 x 20,5 cm)
Fabric B,I:	6 Squares	8 ¹ / ₈ " x 8 ¹ / ₈ " (20,5 x 20,5 cm)
Fabric J:	5 Squares	8 ¹ / ₈ " x 8 ¹ / ₈ " (20,5 x 20,5 cm)
Fabric H,O,Q,R:	4 Squares	8 ¹ / ₈ " x 8 ¹ / ₈ " (20,5 x 20,5 cm)
Fabric F,K,M,P:	3 Squares	8 ¹ / ₈ " x 8 ¹ / ₈ " (20,5 x 20,5 cm)

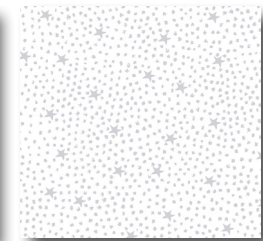

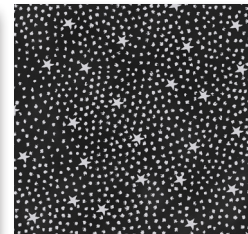

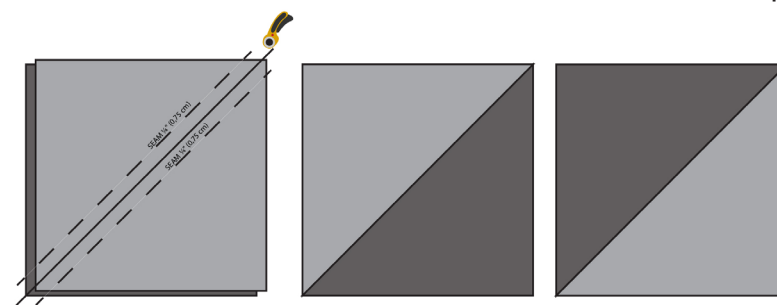

SEWING OF QUILT TOP: Seam allowance is 1/4" (0,75 cm).

Start making the half square triangles.

Take the white squares in fabric A-E and draw a diagonal line from one corner to another.
Note: there is no orientation in the designs so you can draw the line what ever you like.

Now take one square in black fabric O-R and one square in white fabric A-E. With right sides together, sew on both sides of the drawn line. Cut at the drawn line and two squares come forward, see sketch.



Overview of half square triangles:

Black blocks:

Fabric A+Q: 1 square (= 2 half square triangles)
Fabric B+R: 1 square
Fabric C+P: 2 squares
Fabric D+O: 3 squares
Fabric E+P: 1 square

Fabric A+R: 1 square
Fabric C+O: 1 square (use 1)
Fabric C+R: 1 square (use 1)
Fabric D+R: 1 square (use 1)
Fabric E+Q: 3 squares

Blue blocks:

Fabric A+I: 2 squares (use 3)
Fabric B+H: 1 square (use 1)
Fabric C+F: 2 squares
Fabric D+I: 3 squares (use 5)
Fabric E+G: 2 squares
Fabric E+J: 1 square (use 1)

Fabric A+J: 2 squares
Fabric B+I: 1 square
Fabric C+J: 2 squares
Fabric E+F: 1 square
Fabric E+H: 3 squares (use 5)

Light blue blocks:

Fabric A+M: 1 square
Fabric B+N: 2 squares
Fabric D+L: 1 square
Fabric E+K: 2 squares (use 3)

Fabric B+L: 1 square
Fabric C+K: 1 square
Fabric D+M: 2 squares (use 3)

Trim each block to size 7½" x 7½" (19 x 19 cm).

Position the squares as layout on page 4.

Join the squares into rows and afterwards join the rows.

The quilt top is now created.

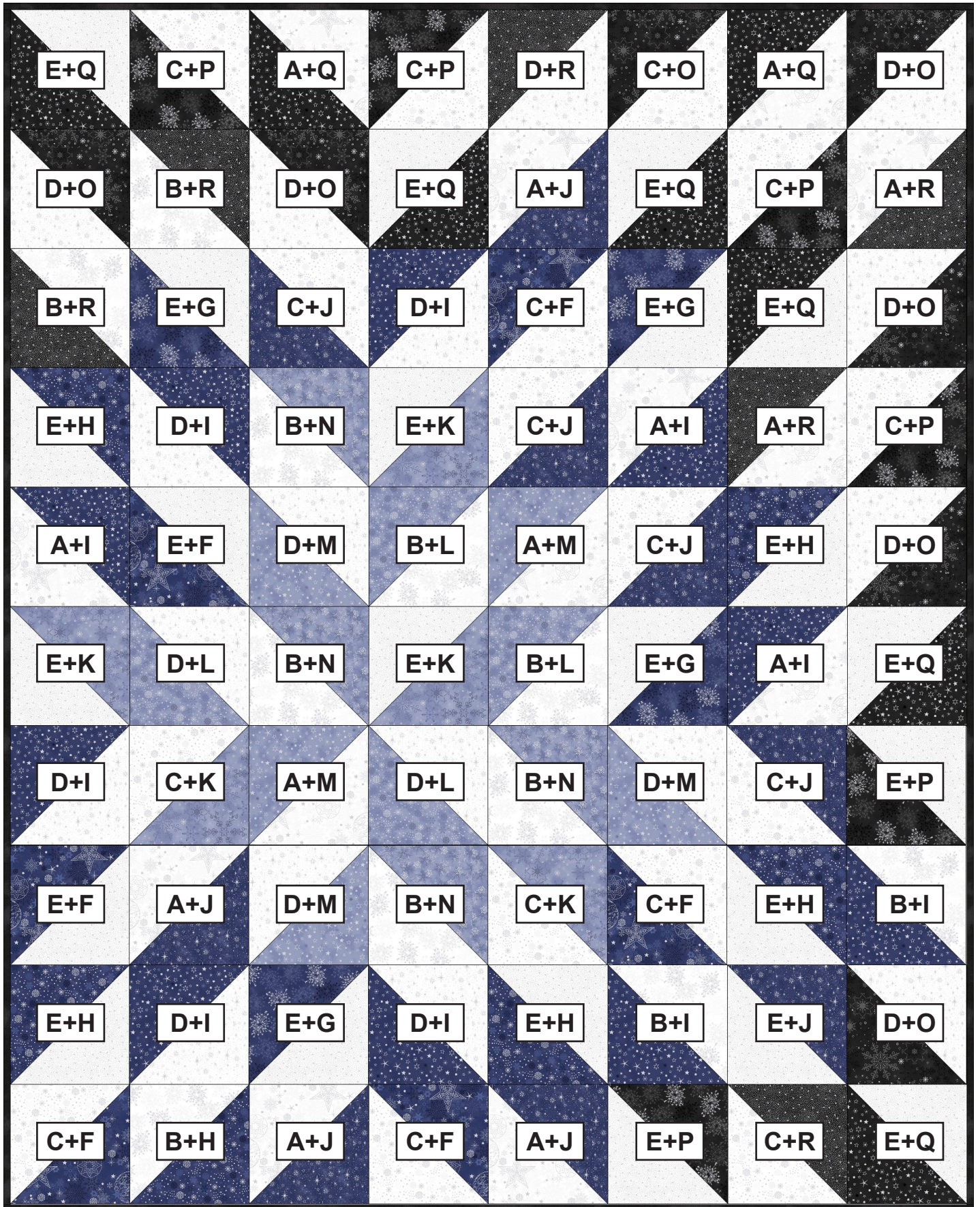
QUILTING AND BINDING:

Layer top, batting and backing fabric and baste the pieces.

Quilt as you prefer by hand or by machine ➡.

Sew hanging sleeve in backing fabric and place under top binding in fabric S ➡.
