

Materials

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

1 panel 1639P-55 Swan Panel - Purple 1/3 yard 1634-20 Hummingbirds - Lt. Pink 3/8 yard 1638-76 Tie Dye Texture - Turquoise 3/8 yard 9570-09 JotDot - Marshmallow 3/8 yard 9570-45 JotDot - Gold

1/2 yard 1632-55 Dragonflies – Purple

7/8 yard 9570-55 JotDot - Purple

1-5/8 yards 1636-74 Birds and Dragonflies with Flowers - Sky

4 yards 1633-11 Floral Allover - Lt. Blue for backing 67" x 75" piece of Air Lite $^{\otimes}$ Colour Me 100% Cotton batting

Cut Fabrics

Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise indicated.

From 1639P-55 Swan Panel – Purple:

*Trim panel to 33-1/2" x 41-1/2".

From 1634-20 Hummingbirds - Lt. Pink, cut:

*Four 2" x WOF strips for border 2.

From 1638-76 Tie Dye Texture – Turquoise, cut:

*Seven 1-1/2" x WOF strips for border 8.

From 9570-09 JotDot - Marshmallow, cut:

*Ten 1" x WOF strips: five for border 3, five for border 5.

From 9570-45 JotDot – Gold, cut:

*Four 1" x WOF strips for border 1.

*Five 1-1/2" x WOF strips for border 6.

From 1632-55 Dragonflies – Purple, cut:

*Five 3" x WOF strips for border 4.

From 9570-55 JotDot – Purple, cut:

*Ten 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

From 1636-74 Birds and Dragonflies with Flowers – Sky, cut:

*Two 5-1/2" x **LOF strips** for border 7 – sides. *Four 5-1/2" x WOF strips for border 7 – top/bottom.

Assemble Quilt Top

- 1. For border 1, measure the vertical length of the panel through the center and trim two 1"9570-45 JotDot Gold side strips that length. [Do this in case you were unable, due to the printing process, to trim the panel as requested in the cutting instructions.] Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Trim two 1"9570-45 JotDot Gold border top/bottom strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt top. Press the seams toward the borders.
- 2. For border 2, join the four 2" 1634-20 Humming-birds Lt. Pink border strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut two border strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.
- 3. Repeat Step 2 with the five 1"9570-09 JotDot Marshmallow strips to make and add border 3.
- 4. Repeat Step 2 with the five 3"1632-55 DragonfliesPurple strips to make and add border 4.
- 5. Repeat Step 2 with the five 1" 9570-09 JotDot Marshmallow strips to make and add border 5.
- 6. Repeat Step 2 with the five 1-1/2" 9570-45 JotDot Gold strips to make and add border 6.
- 7. For border 7, measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and trim the two 5-1/2" x LOF 1636-74 Birds and Dragonflies with Flowers Sky border strips that length. Sew on strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew together the four 5-1/2" x WOF strips with straight seams. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that


length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom.

8. Repeat Step 2 with the seven 1-1/2" 1638-76 Tie Dye Texture – Turquoise strips to make and add border 8.

Finishing

9. Create a quilt sandwich with the batting between the quilt top and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting, and trim batting and backing even with raw edges of the quilt top.

10. Join the ten 2-1/2" 9570-55 JotDot – Purple binding strips together end to end using a diagonal seam to make one long strip. Fold in half lengthwise and press. Sew binding to the edges of the quilt, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold binding to the back of the quilt and stitch it in place by hand to finish.
